By bus

76, 341, 381, RV1 – stop at York Road.

12, N44, 53, 148, N155, N159, N381, 453 – stop at Westminster Bridge Road during the night.

N3 – night bus stops at Lambeth Road.

Westminster – District, Circle and Jubilee Lines (10 minutes walk).

Waterloo – Bakerloo, Jubilee, Waterloo and City and Northern Lines (15 minutes walk).

Lambeth North – Bakerloo Line (15 minutes walk).

Waterloo, Waterloo East, Victoria and **Charing Cross** are the nearest railway stations.



The Evelina Children's Hospital is within the central London congestion charging zone. Don't forget to pay the charge for the day you travel. There are machines in the car park.




